

Airport Fire needs to replenish water, left scene Deployed Purple K Fuel Type Foam	5:45 PM
Deployed Detours for Airport Traffic	5:55 PM
Propane Tanks exploded per camera	5:56 PM
Airport Fire is on back scene with 3000 gallons water	5:58 PM
FCP on scene assisting vehicles in back of queue ran out of gas	6:43 PM
Fire out and cleaning up debris to shoulder	8:22 PM
FCP Unit 509 & 505 traffic policing closing ramps	8:25 PM
