

Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Awarded Community Projects in Southeast Michigan

The recently passed FY 2026 federal appropriations bills included significant funding for Southeast Michigan communities. These investments total more than \$152 million in new funding to 108 projects to address critical needs across the region, from road and nonmotorized infrastructure investment to water and sewer improvements, to addressing health and education needs, and much more.
